Trip overview

Kathmandu - Helicopter up to 3600 (Yangle Kharka) or trek to Everest BC - Makalu Base Camp - Climbing - Makalu Base Camp - Kathmandu



Why go there?

This season we decided to offer an expedition to Makalu with a full service including helicopter transfers.

The high level organization of the expedition allows to ensure the maximum safety of climbers.



Itinerary

Day 1

Arrive in Katmandu. Accommodation in the hotel.

Days 2

Katmandu. Formal procedures with documents, checking gear.

Day 3

Flight from Kathmandu to Yangle Kharka (3600m). Kathmandu - Lukla by plane, Lukla - Yangle Kharka by helicopter. // Another option for acclimatisation - to the Everest Base with an overnight stay in the Base is possible. Then flight from Dingboche to BC Makalu.

Day 4

Trek to Langma La (4450m)

Day 5

Trek to Makalu Base Camp (4800m)

Day 6

Acclimatization at Makalu Base Camp (4800m)

Day 7

Trek to Advanced Base Camp (5600m)

Days 8 - 9

Acclimatization in the Advanced Camp (5600m)

Day 10 - 24

Period of acclimatization and rotation between camps

Day 25 - 34

Climbing period to the top of Makalu (8485m)

Day 35 - 36

Descent to BC Makalu (4800)

Day 37

Flight from BC Makalu to Kathmandu (via Lukla)

Day 38

Kathmandu

Day 39

Flight home

Necessary travel papers (documents)
